While teaching online job search at the Boston Computer Society and elsewhere, she turned to job-hunt.org as a resource, saw the potential, and decided to buy it in 1998. Staggeringly impressive at the time, the site boasted 1,400 inbound links with about 2,000 outbound links. Susan and Job-Hunt have been quoted by TIME Magazine, The New York Times, The Wall Street Journal, Fortune Magazine, Business Week Online, and many other books, publications, and Websites. In addition, Susan has been interviewed on radio and television. Susan is a deeply proud veteran of the U.S. Marine Corp and Job-Hunt dedicates special attention to veteran job search.

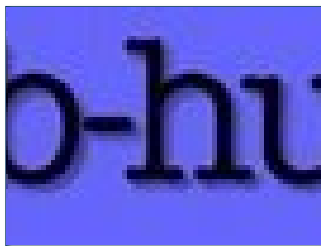
